


Captcha feature

- Captcha code on the Login screen
 - The Login functionality has been updated by addition of a new field on Login form.
 - Login form now shows Captcha code to the users.
- Enter Captcha code
 - User can see Captcha code on the screen.
 - User needs to enter this code in a new field (Enter Code).
 - User cannot login to the application without entering captcha code.
 - Captcha code is case sensitive. User needs to enter the code in the same case as shown.
- Reload Captcha code
 - User can Reload Captcha code by clicking on reload icon next to Captcha code.
 - Once reloaded, user must enter the new code in the field.
